



# Eco Abrolhos Passenger Info - Boat Out & Boat Back

## ★ WHAT IS INCLUDED:

- Breakfast, lunch, dinner, morning, and afternoon teas
- Self-serve tea, coffee, and biscuits from the servery
- Chilled and filtered fresh water
- All shore excursions
- All linen is supplied including beach towels
- Shampoo, conditioner, soap, and hairdryer in ensuites
- Snorkelling equipment - you are welcome to bring your own snorkelling equipment or use ours at no extra cost
- Pearl Farm visit

## ★ WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED:

- Alcohol - The vessel is licensed and drinks are available from the bar, charged to your room tab. **Strictly no BYO**
- Soft drinks and bottled water
- Espresso Coffee - available at the lower bar all day (fee applies)

## ★ WHAT TO BRING:

- Bathers
- A Spray Jacket or Wet Weather Jacket
- An insulated rash top or wetsuit for snorkelling
- Sunburn Cream
- A hat and sunglasses - Polarised sunglasses are best suited
- Shoes for walks that will get wet – a hard sole & coverage of entire foot for protection
- Warmer clothing for evenings or outside
- Camera
- Seasick medication (if required)

## ★ BOARDING INFORMATION:

- Check-In commences from 5:00pm at Fisherman's Wharf on Connell Rd, West End (See map below for directions)
- Complimentary Pick-up is available from your accommodation from 4:15pm if you are not arriving in a vehicle. A more accurate collection time will be provided closer to departure
- Vehicle storage will be at the Fisherman's Wharf for the duration of your cruise and security monitored by the Geraldton Port. Vehicles left at this location are at your own risk. Please take precautions to secure your vehicle such as locking doors and removing any valuables
- The office location is 295 Marine Terrace, Geraldton. Our contact phone number is (08) 9964 5101 if you need to call us
- A vessel induction will occur onboard from 6:00pm & will be followed by a pizza night (Gluten free option available)
- Departure from Geraldton for the Abrolhos Islands is at 6:00am the following morning

## ★ WHAT IS AVAILABLE ABOARD?

- There is a small gift shop onboard. Items include Eco Abrolhos shirts, jumpers, hats, caps, stubby holders, water bottles, books and postcards
- A fully licensed bar. Beer, wine, spirits, soft drinks, bottled water, and espresso coffees are available.
- Onboard purchases will be charged to your cabin. Settlement of the account occurs prior to disembarking. Eftpos, Visa, or Mastercard are accepted. *Sorry no cash settlement.*

## ★ PHONE & INTERNET RECEPTION:

- Telstra is the most reliable service provider at the Abrolhos Islands. The vessel has a Telstra booster onboard to assist with the strength of the signal. However, the signal is not always strong, and reception can be intermittent or not available at many of the areas we visit
- Satellite Wi-Fi is available onboard (fee applies)
