



Eco Abrolhos Passenger Info – Wyndham to Broome

☆ WHAT IS INCLUDED:

- Breakfast, lunch, dinner, morning and afternoon tea
- Self serve tea, coffee and biscuits (24 hrs)
- Chilled/filtered drinking water
- All excursions except Optional Extras tours (fee applies)
- Fishing experience – rods, reels bait, tackle and lures
- All linen including beach towels
- Shampoo, conditioner, soap & hairdryer in each ensuite
- Laundry service
- Complimentary transfers at beginning & end of each cruise

☆ WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED:

- Alcohol - the vessel is licensed and drinks are available from the bar, charged to your cabin
Strictly no BYO.
- Soft drinks and bottled water
- Espresso coffee - available at the lower bar all day (fee applies)
- Optional Extras Tours - subject to 3rd Party availability
- Traditional Land Owner Visitor Passes

☆ AVAILABLE ON BOARD TO PURCHASE:

- A small gift shop is onboard the vessel to purchase merchandise which includes t-shirts, jumpers, hats, caps, stubby holders, water bottles, postcards and books
- All onboard purchases will be charged to your cabin
- Settlement of all accounts will be required prior to disembarking.
Please Note: We are a cashless vessel and accept EFTPOS, Visa, and Mastercard only

☆ WHAT TO BRING:

- Water Bottle plus small backpack for excursions
- A spray jacket/wet weather jacket
- Bathers
- Sunglasses (Polarised Sunglasses are best suited for this type of trip). We recommend you bring a lanyard for your glasses to prevent loss in the water
- Shoes for walks that can get wet
- Warmer clothing for evenings or outside
- Camera (and binoculars if you're a keen bird watcher)
- Seasick medication (If required)
- Sun cream
- A "Hawaiian" themed outfit for Hawaiian night

☆ VESSEL INDUCTION:

By law all guests must have a vessel induction onboard the Eco Abrolhos prior to departure. There will also be a compulsory life jacket and muster station drill for all guests within the first 24 hours after departure.

☆ BOARDING INFORMATION:

The coach will collect you from your accommodation from 7am on the day of Boarding. A more exact time will be communicated closer to departure.

☆ DEPARTURE INFORMATION:

Our transfer Coach will collect you from Broome Port at approx. 9am Occasionally this may be delayed due to weather conditions. Our Coach will take you to your requested location in Broome. ETA is approximately 10am so if you are booking on-going flights, we recommend you fly after 2pm to allow for any potential delays.

☆ PHONE & INTERNET RECEPTION:

Eco Abrolhos carries a satellite system onboard that provides limited internet access. Access tokens may be purchased on board (\$50 - 5 Days or \$120 - 14 Days). Mobile reception is virtually nil during the cruise.

☆ TRAVEL INSURANCE:

We strongly recommend all passengers obtain Travel Insurance to cover any unexpected need to cancel their cruise or the need for medical evacuation from the Kimberley.

Please Note: Medical evacuation is very expensive from the Kimberley. Evacuation costs are required to be paid at the time of evacuation and is not be covered by Medicare or 000 assistance.
