Background

This Position Description has been established to outline the tasks associated with the role of Engineer within the operation of tours and during maintenance when not at sea.

Hours of Work

The scheduled and expected hours of work are from between 0630 – 2100 with regular breaks throughout this time.

Reporting Relationships

Reports to: Vessel Master & Manager

Reports to you: No employee management role although staff are expected to report any faults / defects they notice directly to the engineer for attention.

Primary role

Ongoing monitoring of all equipment on assigned vessel and repair / maintain items as necessary in order to keep the vessel facilities fully functional.

Duties & Responsibilities

- 1. General monitoring of mechanical (engines, refrigeration, air conditioning, desalination etc.) systems and all sundry engineered systems installed on the vessel. Identify & record items needing attention.
- 2. General monitoring of vessel Fixtures and Fittings, including plumbing and lighting systems. Identify & record items needing attention.
- 3. Plan & undertake unscheduled repairs and maintenance on items noted for attention.
- 4. Undertake preventative maintenance as and when required by established schedules as well as attending to non-conformity items using the onboard register.
- 5. Complete all documentation updates as required under the vessel Safety Management System.
- 6. Prepare a schedule of all maintenance items requiring attention in order of priority, confirm schedule with Vessel Master and replace / repair components as required.
- 7. Undertake sundry other tasks as may be required, or directed to by the Vessel Master, to ensure the smooth running of the vessel and the operation as a whole.
- 8. Conversing with passengers, conducting engine room tours and attending to their maintenance requests.
- 9. May be required to conduct watches on the bridge if the candidate holds an unrestricted Master 24m under the Masters Standing Orders and following COLREGS.

Other requirements

1. Assist with sundry tasks necessary around the vessel that may be required. These tasks include unloading delivery trucks, rubbish bag removal to skip bins, pontoon hose downs, sullage tank emptying and general day to day tasks.
